Subject: Airport Hot Topics

For your review, below is a listing of issues affecting the Chester County/G.O. Carlson Airport (MQS).

## NEW BUSINESS

- \* **Airfield Sign Installed:** On October 11<sup>th</sup>, the last of the three “No Hover Taxiing on Taxiway alpha” sign, was installed. That sign was placed near the Runway 11 Aircraft Run-up Area.
- \* **Fire Extinguisher Inspected:** On October, Kistler O’Brien Fire protection company performed its annual inspection on the Authority fire extinguishers located in the terminal and maintenance buildings.
- \* **Trees Cut Down:** On October 16<sup>th</sup>, four dead trees adjacent to airport property along Aviation Way were cut down.
- \* **Airport Snow Plan Review Meeting:** On October 30<sup>th</sup>, Chester County Area Airport Authority representatives met with airport corporate tenants, to review MQS’s Snow Plan, Snow Removal Protocol and to address any questions or concerns they may have about snow removal activity at MQS.
- \* **Drive-thru Gate Repaired:** On October 20<sup>th</sup>, the Plug in Power Supply Unit was repaired on the Lindbergh Boulevard drive-thru gate.

## OLD BUSINESS

- \* **Snow Removal Equipment:** All of the equipment has been prepped and is ready for the 2012-2013 winter season.
- \* **Airport WIFI Availability Project:** The Antenna installations (2 at the T-Hangars, 1 at Hangar #3) has been finalized for this project.
- \* **Scrap Metal Project:** More airport scrap metal has been delivered and sold to the Metal Fabrication Recycling Company, in Parkesburg, PA.
