Subject: Airport Hot Topics

For your review, below is a listing of issues affecting the Chester County/G.O. Carlson Airport (MQS).

NEW BUSINESS

- * **Security Camera Installed:** On September 10th, a camera was installed on the terminal building roof. The camera will display a view of the aircraft Transient ramp.
- * **Card Reader Repaired:** On September 11th, a loose wire was repaired on the Lindbergh Boulevard drive-thru gate.
- * **Aviation & Aerospace Conference:** September 12th – 14th, I attended this conference. The sessions that I went to discussed, 1) Building Community Support for Your Airport, 2) Managing Your Risk Portfolio and 3) Educating Local Airport Policy Makers. The conference was held at the Best Western Hotel in Lancaster, PA
- * **Airfield Signs Installed:** On September 24th and 27th, two signs that read “No Hover Taxiing on Taxiway Alpha”, were installed on the airfield. One was placed near the runway 29 aircraft “Run-up” area and the other, adjacent to the aircraft “Transient” ramp. The third and final sign is still in the process of being made, and will be placed near the runway 11 aircraft “Run-up area.”

OLD BUSINESS

- * **Rubber Bumper Installation:** On October 5th, Hoover Building Specialist will install the rubber bumpers on the T-Hangar buildings.
