For your review, below is a listing of issues affecting the Chester County/G.O. Carlson Airport (MQS).

NEW BUSINESS

Terminal Building Handicap Ramp: On September 3rd, the terminal building handicap walk-way/ramp was repaired.

Water Spouts Repaired: On September 10th, the Hangar #2 down spouts were repaired.

Painting of Taxiway Markings: On September 15th, all of the taxiway “Hold Short” lines were repainted.

Equipment Barn: On September 23rd, a new roof was installed on the barn.

OLD BUSINESS

Emergency Generator Project: On September 4th, gas line trenches were dug. On September 11th, an additional 6 inches of concrete was poured on the old generator base. The additional length will be needed to house the new 25 kilowatt generator. On September 19th, concrete was poured for the two generator bases. On September 22nd, a transfer switch was installed. On September 23rd, the generator bases were mounted

Hangar #2 Stairs Project: On September 7th, the sidewalk that leads to the hangar stairs was repaired. On September 30th, the stair handrails were painted.

Storm Drains Repair: This project is still in progress.
